Emergency Lunches- Alicia presented:

First 2 weeks of school we issued 11 emergency lunches and last week 7

Change to streamline the lunches was made so parents are not called before student receives their lunch now. Teacher completes the form and lunches are immediately issued. Emails for payment are still sent out monthly.

Teacher Appreciation- Julia presented:

PSO provided snacks to staff day before school started

PSO provided El Pollo Loco for lunch 8/23 half-day

Monthly teacher lunches to be provided by PSO by parent donations. Months are split into grade level so each grade should only be responsible to provide lunch twice yearly
