- Treasurer-AliciaT. presented: account balance of \$12,293.92. PSO Treasurer email was part of a phishing scam so the email has been removed from the website. No critical information was compromised. Great Hearts IT is involved and working on a permanent solution for all schools.
- Lunch Program- Sylvia presented: volunteers for Q3 are all full and for Q4 are almost half full
- Emergency Lunches- Alicia D. presented: 46 lunches are still unpaid. 15 new lunches were handed out in 7 days. 9 unpaid lunches have been sent 4 or more emails requesting payment; 8 are two or more and 29 are 1 email. Square payment has been set up and is slowly working. 1 unpaid lunch from November and 1 unpaid from August 2019 were paid through square. Role of checking lunches was removed from teachers because it felt like a burden, but maybe to piggy-back off attendance might work better. The idea of volunteers helping check for lunches or and automated call or text to parents discussed but many details to work out. This program is not a legal obligation but a service offered by the PSO; however currently with the cost of the unpaid lunches this cannot sustain itself. Lunches are needed replenishing approximately every 10 days whereas compared to last year PSO was replenishing every 3 weeks. The program may need to freeze or be indefinitely ended. Money could be raised to pay for unpaid lunches by other willing families at the beginning or the end of the year.
